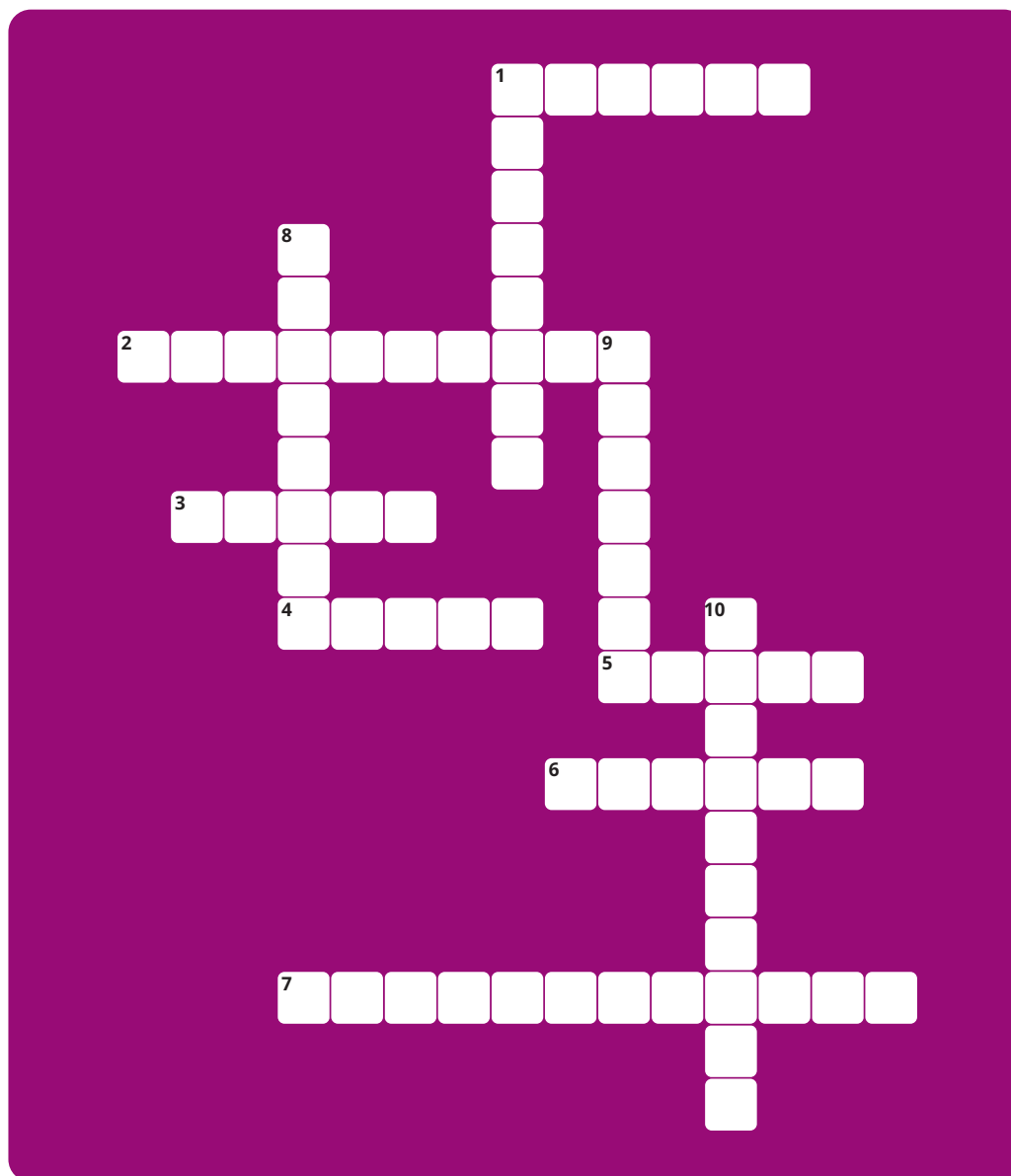


In addition to fully funded internet, N4L offers a range of safety and security services to help protect your school's network and support safer online learning.
